by the Board of Trustees of the Bail Fund of the Civil Rights Congress of New York, for the uses and purposes of said Bail Fund upon the following terms and conditions:

- 1 Said moneys shall be employed only for the purpose of posting bail for defendants in cases involving violation of civil rights, and the Trustees of the Bail Fund shall have sole authority, under the regulations and resolutions adopted by the Board of Trustees, to determine for whom bail shall be posted.
- 2 Said moneys shall be repaid to the lender without interest upon 30 days notice in writing, providing, however, that repayment of loans shall not be made in such a manner as to imperil the safety of any individual for whom such
- 3 That the depositor shall at the time that he applies for the return of the moneys loaned by him to the said Board of Trustees, accompany his application with this Certificate of Deposit and that no money shall be returned except upon surrender of this Certificate of Deposit.

moneys may have been posted as bail, and the Trustees shall have sole authority to determine whether such peril exists; and provided further that the 30 days of notice may be waived by the Trustees to permit immediate return of any loan.
