IN NAME OF 50,000 MEMBERS OF JEWISH AMERICAN SECTION OF INTERNATIONAL WORKERS ORDER,
WE WHOLEHEARTEDLY PLEDGE TO YOU ON THIS FATEFUL AND SOLEMN DAY OF THE INVASION
OF FRANCE OUR COMPLETE AND UNSTINTED SUPPORT. AS AMERICANS WE REDEDICATE OURSELVES
TO THOSE GREAT IDEALS OF DEMOCRACY AND FREEDOM FOR WHICH OUR COUNTRY UNDER YOUR
GREAT LEADERSHIP HAS BEEN WAGING A WAR OF LIBERATION. AS JEWS, ~~YOUR GREAT LEADERSHIP~~
~~NASKEEKEWAGINGXAXXWAXXKXLEADERXKX~~ WE LOOK FOR THE QUICK DELIVERANCE OF OUR
BROTHERS IN EUROPE, WHO HAVE SUFFERED DEATH AND HUMILIATION UNDER THE BRUTAL AND
INHUMAN RULE OF NAZI FASCISM. WE STAND READY TO SPARE NO SACRIFICES, MR. PRESIDENT,
IN ORDER THAT THE GREAT ORDEAL OF OUR FIGHTING FORCES AND THOSE OF OUR ALLIES MAY
BE CROWNED WITH SUCCESS. WE PLEDGE TO REDOUBLE OUR EFFORTS IN THE SALE OF BONDS,
BLOOD DONATIONS, AND IN EXECUTING EVERY DIRECTIVE WHICH YOU WILL SEE FIT TO PLACE
UPON US IN ORDER TO INSURE A QUICK AND DECISIVE VICTORY TO OUR ARMS. WE ALSO PLEDGE
BY THE OPENING OF OUR NATIONAL CONVENTION IN MADISON SQUARE GARDEN, JULY FOURTH,
TO SELL A MINIMUM OF ONE MILLION DOLLAR'S WORTH OF WAR BONDS. PLEASE ACCEPT OUR
DEEP FEELINGS OF LOYAL AND PATRIOTIC SUPPORT OF YOUR LEADERSHIP OF OUR LAND IN ITS
PRESENT TRIAL OF STRENGTH WITH THE DARK FORCES OF REACTION AND FASCISM. VICTORY
SHALL BE ACHIEVED BY US AND THOSE JOINED WITH US IN THE GREAT CRUSADE FOR THE FOUR
FREEDOMS.
