
On behalf of the Jewish Council for Russian War Relief, I want to acknowledge with deep appreciation the tremendous cooperation we have been receiving from the Jewish American Section of the International Workers Order.

Your most recent contribution of \$25,000 brings the total from your organization to \$75,000 since you initiated your Tanks and Planes Campaign, a campaign which you subsequently decided to turn into a drive for funds to be turned over to Russian War Relief. This sum was earmarked, at your request, for the purchase of warm blankets for the use of the Red Army--a gift which could hardly be more suitable at the present time.

At the last meeting of the Administrative Committee of the Jewish Council you announced that you planned to contribute at least \$25,000 more at the coming rally at Madison Square Garden on December 14th. We shall see to it that that sum is also earmarked for some worthwhile item that you will designate at the appropriate time.

Frankly, it is difficult for me to find words that will adequately express our appreciation of the work you and your organization have done on behalf of the Russian people. Please convey to your members our feeling that they set a model for all Jewish organizations in this country, not only in the size of their contribution but perhaps even more important, in the spirit with which they have conducted this work. It is this kind of spirit which is needed to bring about unity of thousands of Jewish organizations in a common effort to help the people who have killed more Nazis than all the rest of the allies together.

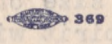
