Dear Mr. Saltzman:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Interim Committee on November 10, 1948 rejected a proposal to continue the status quo of the American Jewish Conference and adopted the following resolution:

"RESOLVED, that a Final Committee be appointed to consist of Lester Gutterman, Hermann Stern, Jacob Marrus, and Louis Lipsky, ex-officio, to wind up the affairs of the Conference, to dispose of its assets, to discharge all its liabilities, in accordance with a schedule of assets and liabilities which will be hereto appended; to conclude all activities of the American Jewish Conference as of December 31, 1948, submitting a report on what it has done to a meeting of the Executive Committee of the Conference to be held on or about January 31, 1949; the Executive Committee, in turn, then to send out a final statement to the delegates of the Conference, to the members of the Interim Committee, and to the public at large; and when that act shall have been completed, to adjourn sine die. And from that day the Conference shall cease to function."

In accordance with this resolution, we are endeavoring to ensure that on December 31, 1948 the affairs of the American Jewish Conference shall be wound up with the dignity and honor befitting an organization which has acted for five years on behalf of American Jewry in matters of post-war Jewish interest. It follows that all debts and commitments must be paid before that date.

As one of the national organizations affiliated with the Conference since its inception, we feel it is your responsibility to discharge your financial obligation now. Please remit the balance of your 1948 assessment without further delay so that we may be helped to liquidate our affairs on the fixed date.

With a deep sense of appreciation for the moral and financial support your organization gave to the American Jewish Conference, we are
